



PHILIPPINE OLYMPIC COMMITTEE
Sport and Art Contest 2012 (National Phase)

CATEGORIES:

- Sculptures
- Graphic Works (paintings, drawings, engravings etc.)

THEME: “Sport and the Olympic Values of Excellence, Friendship and Respect”

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The contest is open to all artists and young talents of Philippine nationality.
2. **CATEGORIES and ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS:** There are two categories of works of arts:
 - **Sculptures** - Dimensions: 1.5 x 1.0 x 1.0 meters, including packaging. Shall not exceed weight of 20kg.
 - **Graphic works** (paintings, drawings, engravings, etc.) – Dimensions: 1.5 x 1.0 meters, including frame (a simple beading is sufficient).
3. **CONTEST PERIOD: December 21, 2011 to February 10, 2012**
4. **SUBMISSION:** Entry forms and Declaration by the artist (See Annexes) must be accompanied by a complete file including all the following for each work of art:
 - The artist’s name and a short biography in a maximum of 400 words;
 - The title of the work and a brief explanation of the work;
 - The type of work, the supporting material and the technique;
 - The dimensions and weight of the work, with and without the packaging;
 - The insurance value in US dollars;
 - Several high quality images (digital or negatives) of the work of art being entered.
 - a. All entries shall be submitted to the PHILIPPINE OLYMPIC COMMITTEE (POC) Office: 3/F Building A, Philsports Complex, Meralco Ave. Pasig City beginning Monday, January 30, 2012.
 - b. The artist shall shoulder the expenses in the transport and delivery (and retrieval, as the case may be) of the work of art to the POC Office.
 - c. Deadline for submission is **FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.**
 - d. The artist understands that the act of submitting an entry and/or affixing his or her signature to the entry constitutes acceptance of all the rules of the contest, whether in the National or the International Phase.

- e. No work of art that already belongs to a museum or a private collection can be entered in this Contest. The works entered in this Contest must be free of any third-party rights. POC shall not be liable in relation to any such third-party rights.

5. JUDGING and PRIZES:

- The Philippine Olympic Committee will select a panel of judges from among the following: local art experts, representatives from the UK Embassy or the Philippine Olympic Committee.
- The Philippine Olympic Committee will award the top three (3) winners of each category in the National Phase with Certificates of Recognition and other prizes. The winning entries shall become the property of the POC and may be made part of special promotions to be conducted by the POC. Under such instances, the artist will be cited accordingly.
- The 1st place winners of each category in the National Phase will be endorsed as the official entries of the POC to the International Phase of the Olympic Sport and Art Contest, and will vie for a chance to win the top prizes. The IOC undertakes to shoulder the expenses incurred in the delivery and return of all packaged works of arts.
- The International Olympic Committee (IOC) will choose six (6) prize-winning works of art in the International phase (the top three in each category) The following awards will be presented in each category:
 - US\$30,000 and a diploma for the first prize.
 - US\$20,000 and a diploma for the second prize.
 - US\$10,000 and a diploma for the third prize.
 - Five further diplomas for runners up.
- The winning works of art shall become the property of the IOC. The IOC reserves all reproduction rights for all works entered in the Contest.

6. RETRIEVAL OF WORKS OF ARTS: Participants may claim their non-winning entries starting **February 29 until March 09, 2012**. Works of arts not claimed after March 09, 2012 will be deemed as a donation to the POC, without any further obligations to the respective artists.
